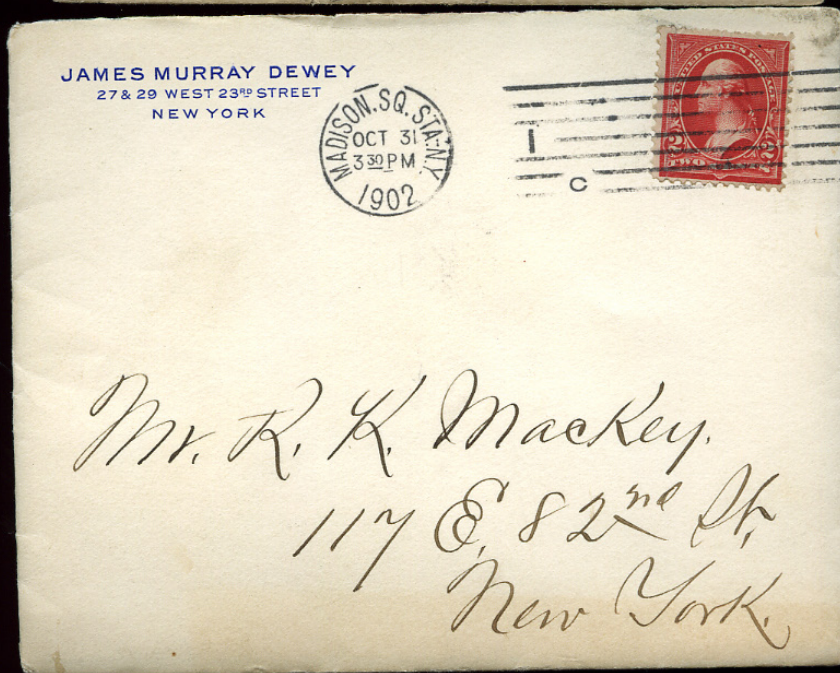
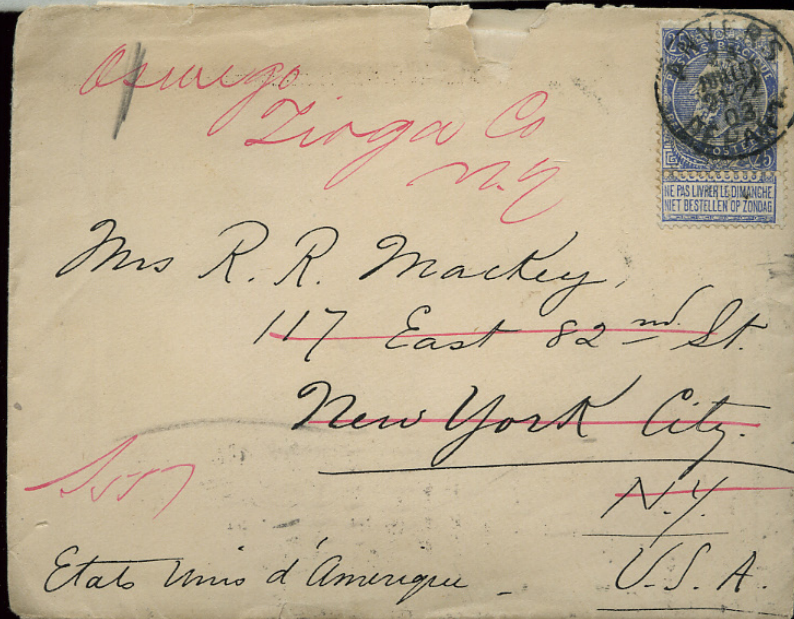
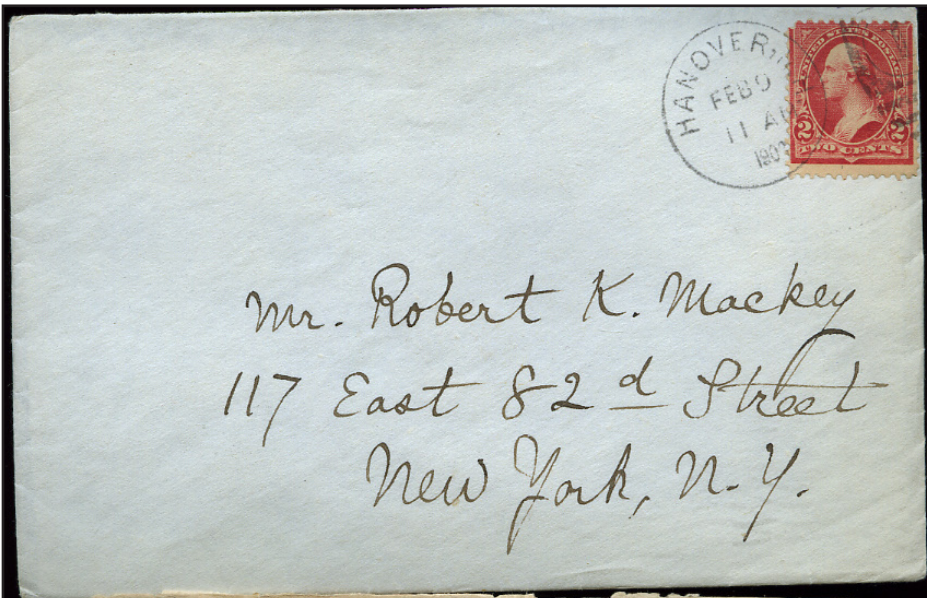

Three autograph letters to the same recipient, Mr. Robert K. MacKay, about his acquisition of the Poe set. They include [1] Three-page Autograph Letter Signed from James Murray Dewey, dated 31 October 1902, telling McKay he can have a set of the Poe that had been previously been reserved for Mr. Crosby. 2] Two-page Autograph Letter Signed from Frederick S. Coburn, the artist for the set, making arrangements to sign McKay's Poe set. 3] One-page Autograph Letter Signed from the editor of the set, Charles T.
